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What is Parent Partnership Stockport?

If your child has special educational needs, you may welcome support from someone who is not directly involved with your child's education but can offer understanding and impartial advice.

Parent Partnership Stockport aims to enable parents and carers to effectively take an active role in the education of their children with Special Educational Needs (SEN).



We are able to discuss issues that affect your child's enjoyment, emotional wellbeing and achievement in school, providing you with information about provision and statutory assessment procedures.

Meetings can be arranged in your home or at our offices in Stockport. Our Parent Partnership workers will be able to:

- Explain the assessment process.
- Listen to your views about your child's needs.
- Make sure that the appropriate children's services are aware of your opinions.
- Put you in touch with parent support groups.
- Help with letter writing.
- Go with you to meetings.

Parent Partnership Stockport can offer information and advice on a range of issues including: Early Years, Early Years Action, School Action, School Action Plus and Statutory Assessment, inclusion, exclusion and support services.
