School Action

- Your child's class/subject teachers will be finding ways to support them in class.
- The teacher will work in partnership with you and the schools Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator (SENCO) to find ways to support your child's learning.
- You will be informed and will receive copies of any specialised plans for this. Progress will be reviewed at least twice a year and you will be informed about this.
- For many children this action will be enough to deal with any difficulties and help them make progress in school.
- Where your child may need more help, the school and SENCO may suggest to you involvement with other agencies. This could be Learning or Behaviour Support or some assessment from the Psychology Service.

School Action Plus

- Your views will be important in planning for your child's education. Progress will be reviewed regularly. Sometimes this may take place at Parents' Evening.
- Teachers, teaching assistants and the SENCO will continue to work together to find ways to support your child in school.
- In addition the school may ask for advice from other Local Authority (LA) specialist support services on ways that your child could be helped. These may be the Learning or Behaviour Support Service, the Psychology Service or other specialist service.
- You will receive copies of any planning to meet your child's needs and the school will set dates to review progress.
- This extra support for a period of time may be enough to deal with any difficulties sufficiently to ensure that progress can be made in school.
