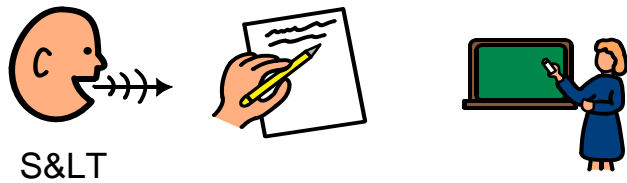

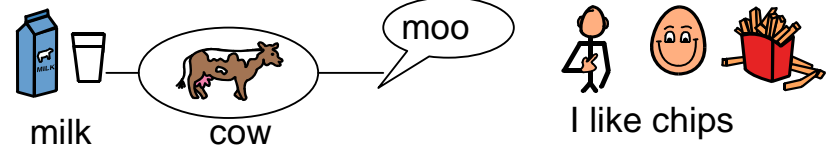
The S< will assess or review your child's progress and then set targets with the teacher to be carried out across the curriculum.

Therapy could include some of the following:

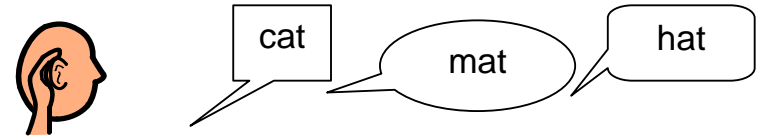


Vocabulary work

Narrative skills - Story telling



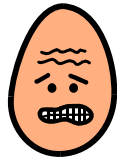
Listening skills and speech sound awareness



Social stories and comic strip conversations to help social communication skills

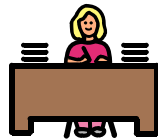


We use signs/symbols to develop children's speech, language and communication



Are you worried that your child's regular day to day therapy is not being carried out by a qualified Speech and Language Therapist?

The reason Speech and Language Therapists write programmes for your child which someone else carries out is because research has shown that for children with language difficulties this is as effective as the therapist doing the therapy themselves and if the child's difficulty is with understanding language it is more effective than the therapist doing it themselves.



The research evidence showed that for speech sound work the therapist doing regular therapy themselves was more effective this is why children with speech sound difficulties are asked to go with their parents to a Speech and Language Therapy clinic and are not seen in school. The therapist will see the child regularly and the parent must also do the work daily at home.

Research Evidence for Therapy Programmes for children with language difficulties:

'Comparable results for direct (clinician-administered) and indirect Treatment were observed in the case of **expressive language**. In contrast, direct intervention was more effective in the case of **speech**, whereas indirect intervention was more effective in the case of **'receptive language.'**
